Notes:

1. 3-year-average cases / rate are defined as the average cases / rate reported in the same month over the previous three years.

4. Hepatitis B: This includes confirmed cases of acute infection only, where both surface antigen (HBsAG) and core antibody (Anti-HBc IgM) are positive.
5. Since the reportable diseases' list was updated in January 2015, this monthly report was correspondingly modified.
6. The two categories "ARO and Nosocomial Organisms" and "Non VPD" have been combined to the category "Other diseases" since Jan 2015.
